The measures we planned and implemented for this smaller group to help keep everyone safe have been successful and I would like to thank all of the staff and children who have made this possible.

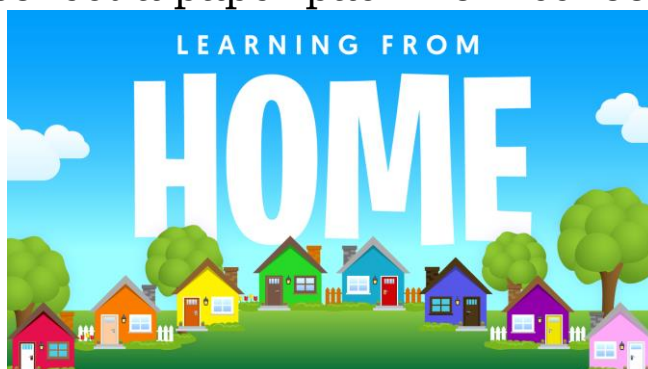
