Thank you to all who supported our fund raiser for Shelter; the homeless charity. Together we raised an amazing £278!

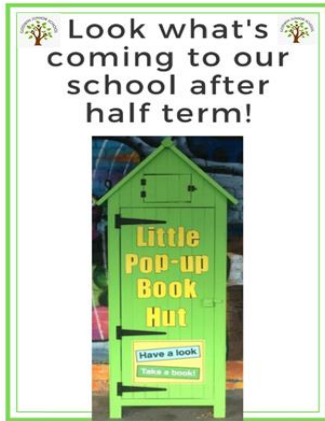
