Head Teacher's Message

Well done to 4K and 4Y, who are halfway through their intensive two-week swimming programme. Everyone has made a tremendous effort so far. Keep it up!

Please remember that following a recent request from a parent, we are hosting a SEND Coffee Morning on Monday morning. It would be fantastic to see families there to share with you what we are doing to further develop provision for children with additional needs and to answer questions you may have.

As the days get shorter, road safety awareness is even more important, especially for children who travel to/from school without an adult. Please can we ask you to help us keep pupils safe - whether walking, scooting or cycling - by reminding them about basic measures, like looking both ways before they cross the road. We hope that by working together we can help children to be more aware of potential dangers. Please can we also ask the very small minority of drivers who drop their children off at the mini roundabout at the junction of Godwin and Cranmer Roads to consider the risk this poses and to stop doing so. We thank you for your help with this.

Finally, a reminder to anyone in our community who can help with our plan for a performing arts studio - we need a qualified architect to offer some of their time for initial drawings (nothing more!) and some-one who has experienced of writing successful funding bids. Thank you in advance.

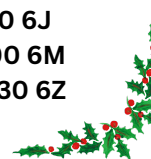

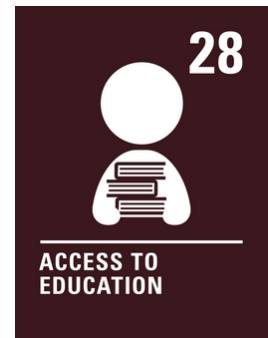

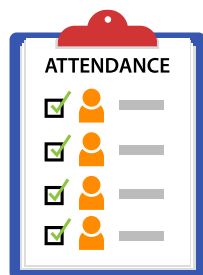
