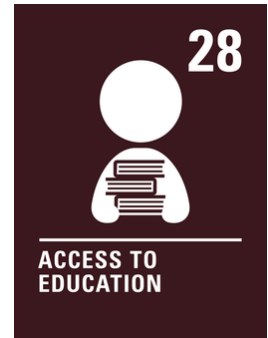

The 18th of July is Nelson Mandela International Day. Nelson Mandela dedicated his life to fighting injustice and inequality. He spent 27 years in prison for standing up for the rights of others. When he was finally released, he became South Africa's first democratically elected president.

Mandela believed that education was the most powerful tool to change the world. Relating this to the UNCRC, **Article 2** emphasises non-discrimination, promoting equality for all children, mirroring Mandela's vision of a fair society. **Article 29** emphasises the child's development in a spirit of understanding, peace, tolerance, equality, and friendship among all people, aligning with Mandela's message of unity and harmony.

This year's theme is: *It's Still in Our Hands to Combat Poverty and Inequity*. Each of us can contribute 67 minutes of service to others on this day - one minute for each year Mandela dedicated to public service. Small acts of kindness and fairness matter.

Think about it...

Nelson Mandela said: "It always seems impossible until it's done." What feels difficult but important to you right now? How could you take one small step towards making it happen?

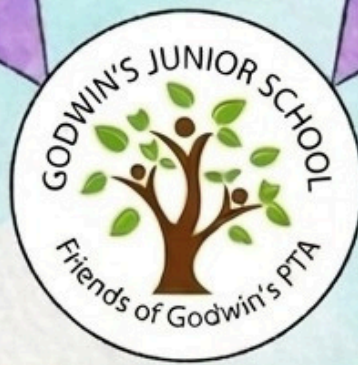

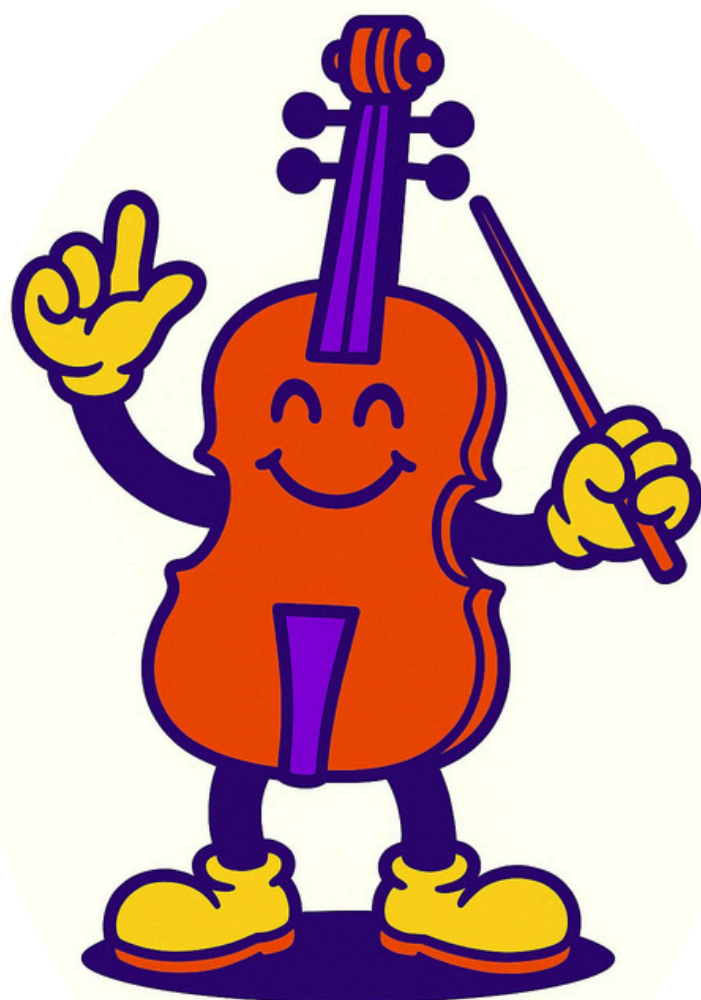
