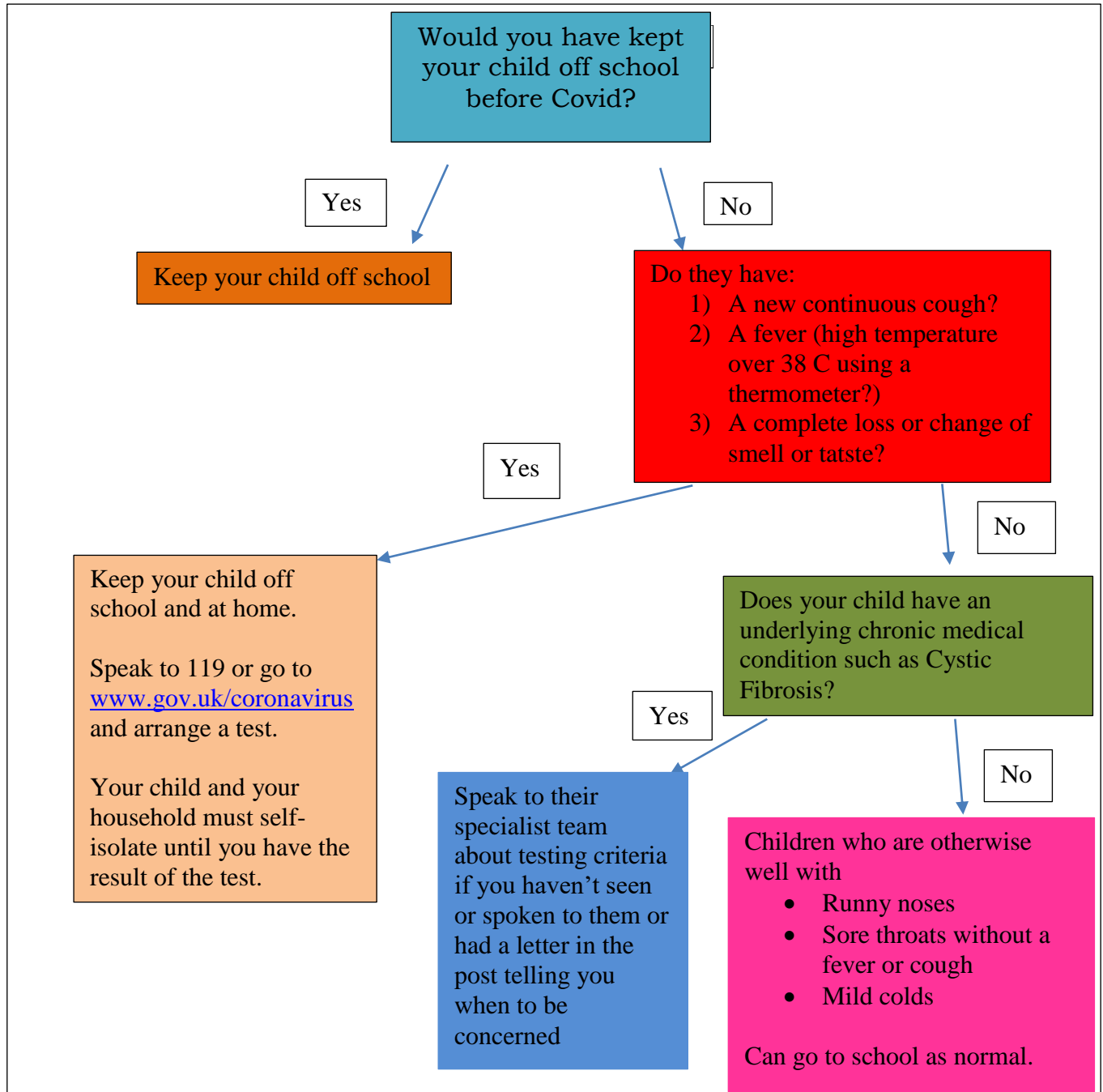


Head Teacher's Message
