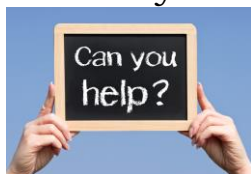


Missing Scooter

Jewellery

Punctuality

We would like to emphasise to all families the importance of their children being in school on time. We have noted that there are some children who persistently arrive late for school. Late arrival means that a child will miss the essential instructions at the beginning of the day and also causes disruption to the rest of the class.

Children may go into class from 8.45am to prepare for the start of the day at 8.55am or can attend Breakfast Club from 8.00am for £3.00 per day.
