


LITERACY

The children have been focussing on grammar and reading to help them prepare for their SATs exams. When using previous SATs papers the children have been unpicking questions to make sure that they are clear exactly what is being asked so that they can give full and precise answers. The children will also be reading a variety of stories from a selection of authors and making comparisons between the themes and structure of these. These discussions will help them to explore the types of reading genres available to them in year 7.

NUMERACY

In maths this half term the children have been focussing on SATs revision, going over particular areas which they have found difficult or need to revisit. They have used past papers to provide experience of the types of questions which they will face and, in particular, focussing on the wording so that they are clear precisely what the question is asking them.

TOPIC

The children are learning about 'The Americas' and how the United States has changed over time. This will include researching the lives of prominent explorers and finding out about trade, imports and exports.

ICT

The children will be linking ICT to their studies in both topic and art. After examining the symbolism of the US flag they will use various software to each design a flag to represent themselves. They will then develop their ICT design skills to create graffiti-inspired artwork.

SCIENCE

The year group will look at light and how we see things. They will have an opportunity to make a model of the human eye and label it. The children will discover how light travels and how it can pass through certain objects and use appropriate scientific vocabulary to explain the process.

RE

In this unit, the children will explore how their time at Godwin and also past life events have changed their thinking and will continue to change over time. This will involve them being reflective and they will develop their ability to listen and respond thoughtfully to the comments of others.

ART

The children will be discovering graffiti and how it can be used as art. They will explore how messages can be conveyed through graffiti art and also look at how the use of colour influences the impact of their work on the viewer.

PE

In outdoor PE the children will be focussing on hockey. They will learn how to control the ball and play in a team. Indoor PE will be focussed on dance in preparation for their year 6 performance.
