Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all of the Parents and Carers who were able to meet with their child's class teacher this week. These conversations are so important in making sure that the partnership between home and school is a strong one and we know that you love the opportunity to see and hear about the progress that your child has made last term.

As many of you will be aware, the theme in this week's assemblies has been 'Do electronic devices harm family life?' We have had lots of opportunities to discuss how we choose to spend our leisure time, linking the question to the British Value of Individual Liberty and the right to spend our free time as we choose. We also talked about how using devices can mean that people don't pay enough attention to those around them and how this links to Mutual Respect.

It was a very close vote, with 52% of the children feeling that devices didn't impact negatively on family life. This contrasted sharply with the opinions of those adults who voted at Parent/Carer Conferences: 80% believed that devices are detrimental. Perhaps you could arrive at a consensus this weekend!

Lastly, well done to our Year 6 children who have prepared so conscientiously for next week's SATs. We hope that the test papers give them the opportunity to show how remarkable they are.
