

Head Teacher's Message

This week we have been discussing bullying in assemblies. We arrived at a definition similar to the Anti-Bullying Alliance's; namely that bullying is deliberate, hurtful and refers to actions that happen more than once. The children reflected on the fact that bullies often single out people who are different in some way, but that being unique is something to celebrate. We agreed that bullying can take on many forms – physical and emotional – but is never the fault of the person on the receiving end. Next week we will be continuing this theme, focussing on why some people bully and what children should do if they are aware that bullying is happening.

This is linked to Article 12 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child: Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes. For more details go to:
