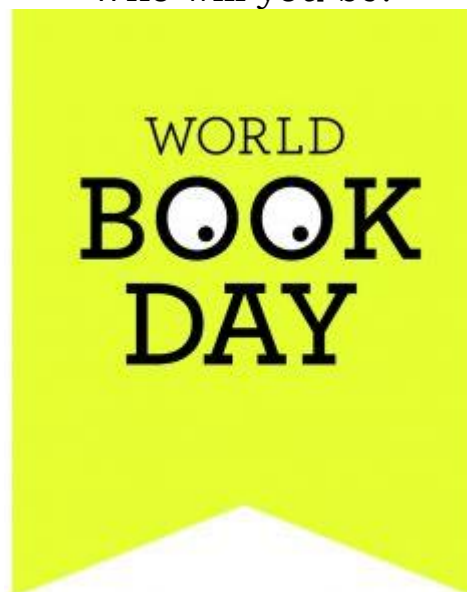
Get Caught Reading
