## Head Teacher's Message

As part of our commitment to keep our children safe, fit and healthy, we met with representatives of the Council's road safety team recently.

We discussed a scheme to try and reduce traffic congestion and pollution, as well as improve road safety as children are walking or cycling to and from school.

The Council is considering a pilot scheme to make the streets around the school a pedestrian and cycle only zone at set times in the morning and afternoon. Vehicles will not be permitted to enter the pedestrian zone between set times unless the driver is a holder of a valid exemption permit. It is expected that such permits will only be issued to residents, businesses and blue badge holders living within the zone.

We have been informed that formal consultation will take place at the start of the new school year (September 2018). Specific details and an opportunity to comment on the proposals will be in the school newsletter in September.

We hope that the scheme will be delivered early next year.

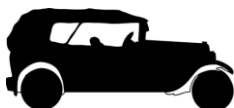
