- To read a variety of performance poems

- To assess the effectiveness of their own writing and edit and improve their work

Geography

The Mediterranean

- To use a map to locate the Mediterranean Sea and its surrounding countries.
- To compare the climate of the Mediterranean and the UK.
- To use books or online sources to research a country in the Mediterranean.

Maths

Geometry

- To recognise angles as a property of shapes
- To identify and draw parallel, perpendicular, horizontal and vertical lines
- To describe 2D and 3D shapes and their properties

Measurement

- To tell and write the time from an analogue clock
- To add and subtract amounts of money to give change
- To measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm) and mass (kg/g)
- To revise calculation strategies
