### Performance Poetry

- To read and respond to a range of poems
- To identify the poetic devices used in poetry such as alliterations, similes and metaphors
- To perform a poem to an audience, using volume, expression and intonation

### Formal invitations

- To identify the features of a formal invitation
- To create a mind map of ideas for a formal invitation
- To identify and use formal language
- To plan and create a formal letter of invitation

## Geography

### Mapping Europe

- To identify different European countries on a map
- To identify human features such as density of population and religion in European countries
- To identify, locate and name rivers on a map of Europe
- To locate, name and discuss mountains in Europe

## Maths

### Fractions and Decimals

- To add two or more fractions and subtract two fractions
- To calculate fractions of quantities
- To recognise tenths as decimals and divide by 10 and 100
- To add, order, compare and round decimals
