Friday 14th September

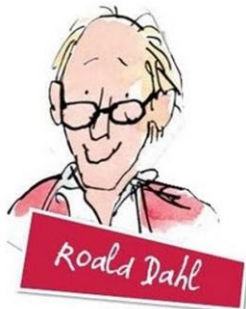
To mark the author's birthday we are holding a fancy dress competition. Dress as a character from one of his books or dress in yellow (his favourite colour) for the day.
