Head Teacher's Message

Our Friday 'Celebration Assembly' is an opportunity for us to reflect on the week's successes and hear how well children are developing their Learning Powers. It was fantastic today to see so many children being rewarded for persevering, collaborating and embracing mistakes – all vital characteristics of being a good learner. At Godwin we believe that cultivating these behaviours is part of our commitment to Article 29 of the UNCRC: Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full.

Please talk to your child about our Learning Powers and when they have developed them at school this week. Ask them whether these key skills are useful in other areas of their life as well.

Good learners:

- Are curious: They want to learn more.
 - Persevere: They keep trying.
- Consider choices: They think carefully about their decisions.
 - Collaborate: They learn from working together.
- Embrace mistakes: They know that they are important for learning.
 - Evaluate: They reflect on what helps them learn.
 - Explain reasoning: They can articulate their ideas.
