Enriching our science curriculum, the children planted bee-friendly flowers and explored the important role bees play in our environment. This week's highlight was a visit from a professional beekeeper, who brought live bees to Godwin and shared fascinating facts about their life cycle and habitats. The experience provided a wonderful real-life link to

pupils' learning on plants - supporting UNCRC Article 29, inspired great curiosity and promoted Sustainable Goal 13.

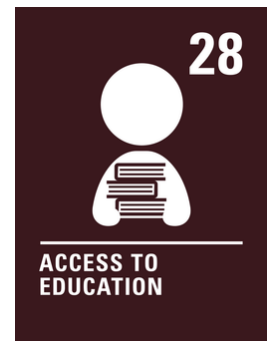

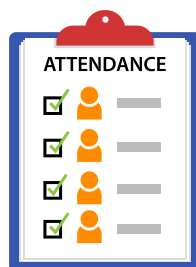

ARTICLE OF THE WEEK



The 12th of June is *World Day Against Child Labour*. Around the world, **160 million** children work in jobs that are dangerous or harmful. Many are prevented from going to school, playing or resting safely. This violates their rights under the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Article 32 of the UNCRRC states that governments must protect children from work that damages their health or blocks their education. Every child has the right to learn, to be kept safe and to have time to play. These rights belong to every child, in every country.

This year's theme is "*Let's Act on Our Commitments - End Child Labour.*" We can make a difference by learning about this issue, talking about it and supporting organisations that protect children's rights around the world.

Think about it... What job would you like to do when you grow up? Draw yourself doing that job. Around your drawing, list the skills, qualifications and equipment you would need to do it safely. What rights help you get there?

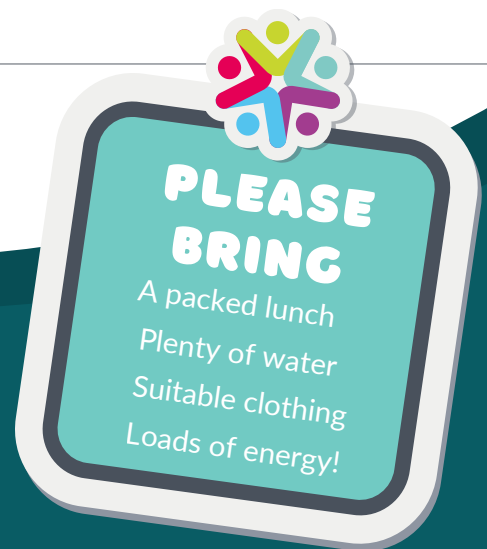
