Head Teacher's Message

This week, Year 6 pupils took part in engaging workshops delivered by Energy Garden. They explored the difference between community gardens and green spaces before identifying green spaces across London and within their local area using Ordnance Survey maps. Pupils also learned about renewable and non-renewable energy sources and enjoyed a hands-on investigation using volt meters to measure electrical output from solar panels placed at different locations around the classroom. The workshops provided an exciting opportunity to develop both geographical and scientific knowledge through practical learning.

"My favourite activity was the solar panel testing using a volt metre." Eva 6M

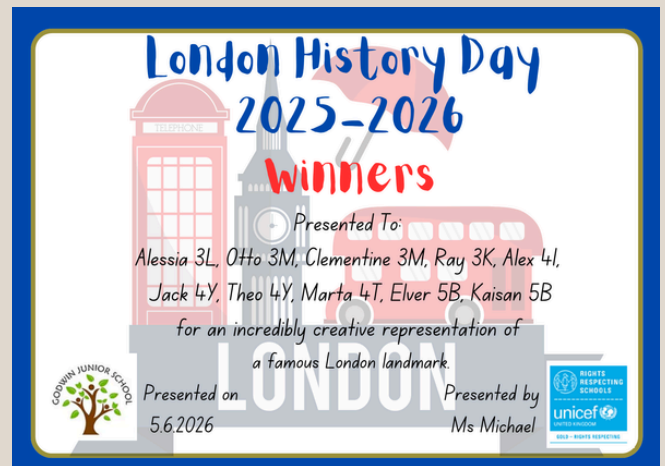

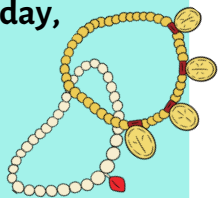


Please can we ask for your help in ensuring that children are dressed appropriately for school each day, including suitable footwear.

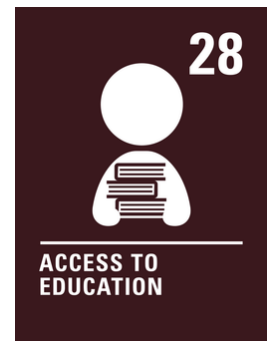

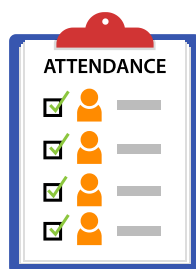
This attendance data is for the week beginning 18th May

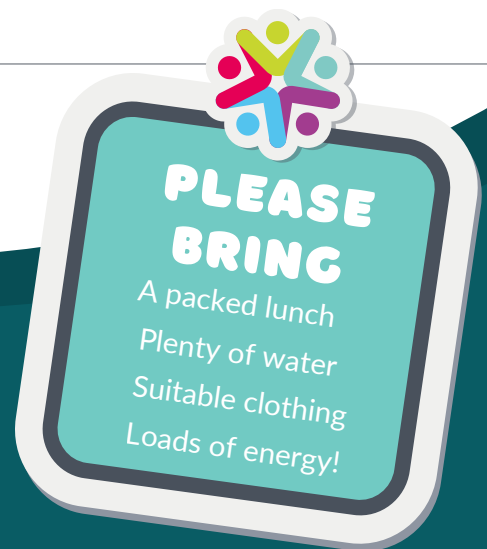
