## Mobile Phones

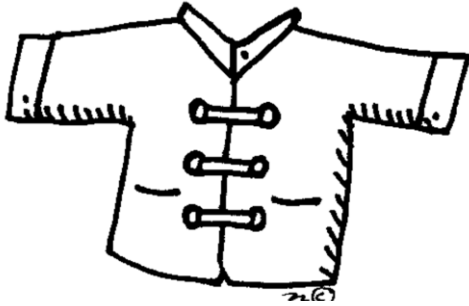
As part of our school safeguarding policy, we respectfully ask that parents/carers refrain from using mobile phones when on school property.
