Our best 'On Time' classes for week ending 6th September were: 3T, 4K, 5T & 6Z with 0 late marks recorded each.

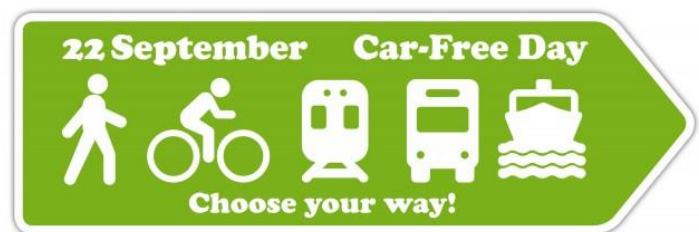
