#### Safer Street Zone

Godwin Junior School pupils previously worked very closely with the local authority to introduce the School Streets initiative to reduce the amount of harmful pollutants in the air our children breathe on their way to and from school each day: UNCRC Article 24: All children have the right to clean air.

Most of our pupils live close enough to walk, scoot or cycle to school. Please consider this option. It's often faster than driving and looking for a safe and legal place to park. Walking is good exercise for children... and for you!

If you really must drive, please allow time to park safely and considerately and do not block entrances, driveways, junctions or stop on double yellow lines. Any cars stopped or parked in restricted areas can hide small children who are about to cross the road. These children may not see approaching cars and motorists may not see the children.

This is particularly a problem at the beginning of the Safer Streets zone, where some parents and carers are dropping off their children without considering the safety of others. Please help us to keep all of our children and community safe.


#### **Book Wish List**


