## Head Teacher's Message

As you may be aware our school is part of a group of 8 schools who work closely together as a soft federation. We are Godwin Junior, Kay Rowe Nursery, Odessa Infant, Park Primary, St James' C. of E. Junior, Sandringham Primary, William Davies Primary and Woodgrange Infant Schools. We are a soft Federation of schools. We have a Joint Strategic committee that includes a Governor from each school and 3 Head Teachers. We feel it is important to keep you informed about our partnership activities so will be giving you regular updates of our work together.

Each year the schools collaborate on projects designed to make each school an even better place to learn. This term teachers have met in their year groups to compare children's writing. This is an important part of staff training as we share successful strategies and ideas to make sure all children make excellent progress. Currently we are developing our "LEARNING POWERS". Each school has identified some champions who are reading, exploring ideas and implementing strategies to help children become better learners.
