To all who celebrate we wish a very peaceful, enjoyable Easter.



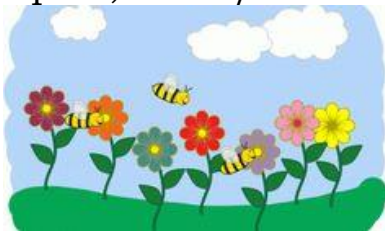
Big Dig & Picnic
