These lessons are provided by Newham Academy of Music and there is a fee payable each term for the lessons.

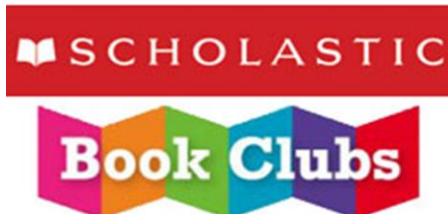
