Earlier this term an ex-pupil spoke in assembly to our year 3 and 4 pupils about her trip to Malawi in the summer. During the trip she helped a nutrition programme supported by Mary's Meals.

This project commits to providing school children with one wholesome hot meal per day – a fortified maize porridge called 'Phala'.

All the money raised at our Porridge Breakfast will be donated to Mary's Meals to help feed the children of Malawi.

It costs the project £10.70 a year to feed a Child in Malawi. Enough food means they can concentrate in school and be motivated to learn.
