Head Teacher's Message

This week, our Year 6 pupils participated in a workshop delivered by Transport for London (TfL). With a focus specifically on the increased independence that the transition to secondary school affords, our children thought about different modes of transport including walking, taking the bus and using the tube network.

Children were asked to consider the responsibilities that come with owning an 11-15 years 'Zip Card' and were encouraged to consider how to travel safely, especially when using the bus or tube on their own or with friends.

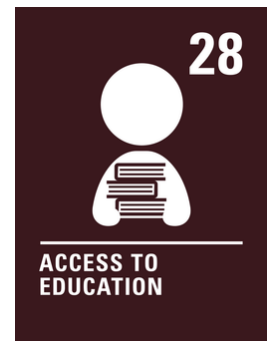

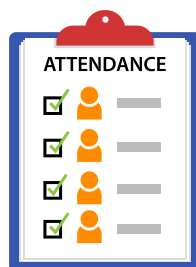

Article 22 of the UNCRRC states that children who are refugees have the right to special protection and help. Whether they have crossed a border or been displaced within their own country, these children deserve safety, education and care.

Many refugees are children. They show extraordinary resilience as they rebuild their lives in new places. **Article 7** reminds us that every child has the right to a nationality and to be cared for. Learning about the experiences of refugees helps us to develop empathy and respect for all.

Think about it... What does the word "courage" mean to you? How might it feel to leave your home and everything you know? How can we show kindness to those who are new to our community?

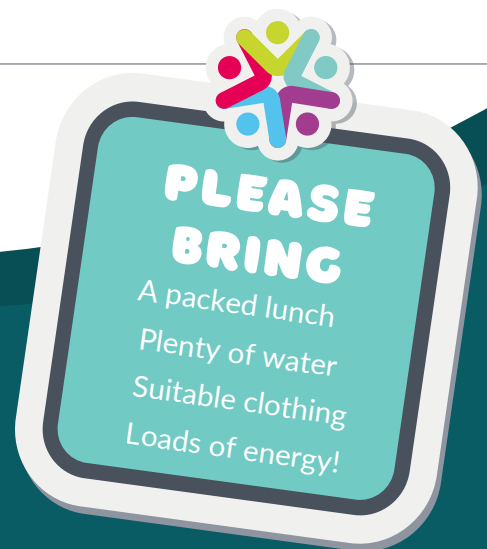
