If you need for your child to arrive earlier than 8.45am there is a Breakfast Club provision in school which is £3.50 per day.

At the start of this new term we would like to remind you that your child needs to wear a coat to school every day.

If possible this coat should be warm and showerproof with your child's name written on the inside label.

Additionally, footwear should be appropriate to the weather of the day.



Sickness Absence & Medicines

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school, please inform the school office by 9.00am on the first day of their absence.

To support your child's earliest return to school, we can accept prescribed medicines to administer on your behalf during the school day.

Any medicine you wish for your child to take must bear the original dispensing label and be accompanied by a letter of instruction stating the time and dose signed by a parent/carer.

PLEASE NOTE: We are not able to accept over the counter medicines that do not have a dispensing label.
