
One important fact about you is: I am an ex paralympic swimmer and a keen swimmer to this day!








#### **Get Caught Reading**

#### **Article of the Week**











International Day of Disabled People is on 3rd December. This global event celebrates and promotes disability equality. It has been observed since 1981, raising awareness of the issues faced by 1 billion people with disabilities and role communities and cultures play in removing obstacles to inclusion.

Article 2 specifies that the Convention applies to all children, regardless of ethnicity, gender, religion, language, skills, other status, thoughts, or family background. Article 23 declares that a disabled child has the right to a full, decent, independent, and active life in the community. Governments must help disabled children and families.


