In assemblies this week we have been focussing on the theme of discrimination and have reflected on the different characteristics which people can be treated unfairly for. As a school, a central part of our vision is that all members of our school community are valued – we have discussed how we show this in our words and actions.

This links to the UNCRC, Article 2: All children have rights and should not be discriminated against.

Next week we will be linking this to Black History Month and talking about how Martin Luther King changed the world through non-violent protest. Please talk with your child about how we should treat individuals based on their behaviour rather than something about them such as religion, skin colour or disability. This reinforces the British Values of Tolerance and Mutual Respect.
