As part of our ethos of promoting tolerance, we will be considering the difficulties faced by refugees and also the enormous contribution which individuals have made to the UK. This builds on the recent Red Cross workshops which our Year 6 children have responded so positively to.

This focus links to the UNCRC Articles 7, 'the right to acquire a nationality'; 22 'that refugee children have the right to special protection' and 38 'that children in war zones should receive special protection.'

Well done to all the Year 6 pupils who worked so hard and so collaboratively and to all parents/carers for their help and generosity.

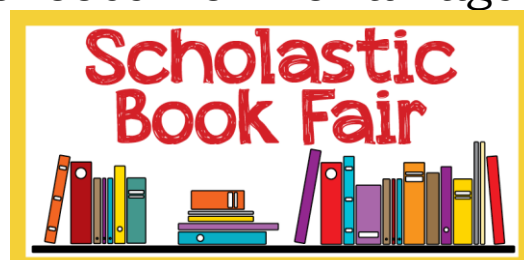


## Scholastic Book Fair
